प्रिय मित्रों, कुछ ही दिनों में हम प्रभु येसु का जन्मोत्सव (ख्रीस्त जयंती) मनाने वाले हैं। इन दिनों मसीही संस्थानों, विद्यालयों और कॉलोनियों को इस आने वाले पर्व के लिए सजाया संवारा जा रहा है। हर दिल में उमंग और उल्लास है इस त्योहार में मनाने के लिए।

इन दिनों सारी कलीसिया संत पिता फ्रांसिस द्वारा प्रस्तावित सिनड (धर्म सभा) में व्यस्त है। कलीसियाई और अन्तर्रकलीसियाई स्तर के साथ ही देशीय व अन्तर्र्देशीय और अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय स्तरों पर विभिन्न सभाएं और विचार गोष्ठियां आयोजित की जा रही हैं। संत पिता फ्रांसिस ने निश्चय ही बहुत मनन-चिन्तन और प्रभु के निर्देशों को आत्मसात् कर ही इस धर्मसभा के आयोजन का निर्णय लिया होगा। वैसे तो हर धर्मसभा के आयोजन का कोई न कोई कारण होता है। उसी क्रम में इससे पहले भी कई धर्मसभाएं आयोजित की जा चुकी हैं। गूगल के अनुसार वर्ष 1967 से अब तक तीस बार इस प्रकार की सभाएं हो चुकी हैं जिनमें से 16 सामान्य सभाएं और तीन असाधारण और 11 अति विशेष सभाएं हो चुकी हैं।

वाटिकन द्वितीय महासभा के बाद संत पिता पॉल षष्ठम ने धर्माध्यक्षों की धर्मसभा स्थापित की। ये धर्मसभाएं संत पिता को सलाह-मशिवरा देती हैं। तब से विश्व के सभी धर्माध्यक्ष समय-समय पर धर्मसभाओं में मिलते और संत पिता को सलाह एवं सुझाव देते रहते हैं।

इस धर्मसभा का धर्मसभाई उद्देश्य क्या है? संत पिता द्वारा शुरु की गई इस वर्तमान सभा का मुख्य उद्देश्य है—कलीसिया की आन्तरिक प्रक्रिया (तन्त्र) को पुन: व्यवस्थित करने हेतु विचार विमर्श और चिन्तन करना तथा कलीसिया के आन्तरिक स्वाभाविक ज्ञान और मिशन प्रचार प्रसार को समझने और स्पष्ट रूप से व्यक्त करने में सहायक होना।

संत पिता की इच्छा है कि इस धर्मसभा में सिर्फ दस्तावेज ही तैयार नहीं किये जायें, किन्तु वास्तविक मुद्दों पर गम्भीर चिंतन किया जाये। उनकी चाहत है कि इस धर्मसभा में हर वर्ग-हर क्षेत्र के व्यक्ति को हिस्सा मिले, सब की बात सुनी जाये और सबको अपनी बात सुनाई जाए, कोई भी अछूता नहीं रह जाए। धर्मसभा में उन्हें भी शामिल किया जाना चाहिए, जो हमसे रूठे हुए हैं या हमसे विरक्त हो गए हैं। धर्मसभा में अन्तर कलीसियाई और सर्वधर्म संवाद-सहयोग के लिए भी विशेष स्थान है। धर्मसभा सबके लिए खुला निमंत्रण है। हमारे समय में यह धर्मसभा हो रही है, यह हमारे लिए कितने सौभाग्य की बात है।

इस बार का क्रिसमस हमारे लिए एक अलग तरह का क्रिसमस होगा। यह हमें याद दिलायेगा कि क्या साथ लाये, क्या छोड़ आये? मंजिल पर पहुंचने का असली मजा तब ही आता है जब साथी साथ हो। इस बार हमारे बहुत से साथी हमें बीच में छोड़कर हमसे आगे निकल गये हैं...एक ऐसी जगह जिसके बारे में जगजीत सिंह अपनी गज़ल में कहते हैं- ''जाने गये कौन से देस, चिट्ठी न संदेस।''

कुछ वर्ष पूर्व जब मैं रोम से पढ़ाई के दौरान बड़े के दिन की छुटिटयों में इंग्लैण्ड गया हुआ था, वहाँ एक चर्च में पुरोहित के रूप में सेवा कर रहा था, तब हर हफ्ते मुझे एक निर्संग होम में बीमारों को देखने और उन्हें पवित्र साक्रामेण्ट देने जाना होता था। वहाँ निर्संग होम में एक एंगलीकन विधवा माता भी थीं। वह मुझसे एक दिन कहले लगीं, 'मैं तुम्हारे ईश्वर को पसन्द नहीं करती।' मैं भौचक्क रह गया। तब उसने कहा, कि 'तुम्हारे ईश्वर ने क्रिसमस के दिन ही मेरे एकलौते बेटे की जान एक एक्सीडेण्ट में ले ली।' मैं भीतर तक हिल गया...क्या सांत्वना देता! तभी मैंने हिम्मत करके उनसे कहा, 'अम्मा, ईश्वर ने तुम्हारे बेटे को ले लिया किन्तु बड़े के दिन ही उसने अपना एकलौता बेटा आपको दे दिया।' पता नहीं कितना वो समझी, कितना उसका दु:ख हल्का हुआ। वह धीरे–से मुस्करा दी...दो बूँदें आँसू की उनकी निराशा भरी आँखों से ढुलक गईं।

वास्तव में क्रिसमस आदान-प्रदान का त्योहार या समय है कपड़े या पुरानी चीज़े बदलने का नहीं। लेकिन अपने आपको बदलने का समय है। आप सबको बड़ा दिन और नया साल मुबारक हो!

Christmas Message

No event in the history of salvation gives us as much joy as the birth of Our Lord Jesus Christ. He comes as the rising sun to give light to those who live in the darkness and the shadow of death. To all those who live in the darkness of fear and anxiety, sin and sickness, discouragement and depression, the good news of great joy is: "Today a Saviour has been born to you." He is the image of the invisible God; to see Him is to see the Father; to have communion with Him is to have communion with God.

He was named Jesus because He was born to save His people from their sins. His birth is news of great joy for us. His birth was a prelude to His death. His humble birth in a manger, immediate persecution by Herod, the massacre of holy Infants of Bethlehem-these are signs indicating the life that awaited Him. They are signs of the cross. But they are also the sign that the broken relationship between us and God will be restored. Jesus sacrifices everything in order to free us and redeem us. His life and death proves that He is indeed the son of the living God. But the son can only be known by faith. Martin Luther says, "The real blessed faith that God's word and work demands is the firm faith that Christ is

born for you and that His birth is yours: that it took place for your sake. For the Gospels teach us that Christ was born for our sake, and that He died and suffered all things for our sake. The angel does not merely say that Christ is born. He says for you, for you He is born. He does not say.' I bring news of great joy'; He says,' to you, I bring news of great joy'."

As St. John says in his letter we need the assistance of the Holy Spirit to say God became man in Jesus Christ (1 Jn. 4:2). Therefore, when we celebrate this great feast of Christmas our attitude must always be one of helpless humility recognizing that it is never by any power of our own that we can take one step of progress in our understanding of the things of God. It is a gift for which we must ask earnestly, sincerely and constantly. For God does not reveal Himself to the clever and conceited people. The mysteries of the kingdom of God are revealed to the little children who are humble. The humble shepherds of Bethlehem were the first ones to receive the good news of Jesus' birth and to have a darshan of the incarnate God. Saint Simeon and Prophetess Anna were humble people and they too were blessed with the darshan of the Messiah. The scripture says very clearly, "God resists the proud and shows favour to the humble" (1 Pet. 5.5).

God not only reveals himself to the humble but He dwells in the hearts of the humble. "For thus says the Most High, He who is enthroned forever, He whose name is holy: I reign exalted and holy, but I am also with him who is contrite and humble in Spirit" (Is 57.15). Mother Teresa says, "Without simplicity and purity you will reason the reality of Jesus and His mother into a dead thing. Your self sufficiency, your selfishness and your intellectual pride will inhibit his coming to live in your heart, because God cannot fill what is already full".

If we do not believe that God became man in Jesus Christ, we remain in the dark; and dark brings fear and sadness. If we do not believe, we miss the true meaning of life and the future has no hope. To believe in the fact that God became man is not to walk in doubt and illusion. It is to step into the world of God, and so into reality. Without faith in the incarnation there can never be true peace, true joy, true hope and good will among people. Without faith in the incarnation celebration of Christmas benefits us nothing. For mystic Angelus Silesius says, "Were Christ born a thousand times in Bethlehem and not in you, you would still be eternally lost." At this Christmas let us approach the crib of Jesus Christ in humility and faith, so that He may be born in our hearts.

महाधर्माध्यक्ष का संदेश (हिन्दी अनुवाद)

मुक्ति के इतिहास की कोई भी घटना हमें इतना आनन्द नहीं देती जितना कि हमारे प्रभु येसु ख्रीस्त के जन्म की घटना देती है। उसका आगमन उस उगते हुए सूर्य के समान होता है जो अंधकार और मृत्यु की छाया में रहने वालों को प्रकाश देता है। उन सब लोगों के लिए जो भय और चिन्ता, पाप और बीमारी, निराशा और हताशा के अन्धकार में रहते हैं, आनन्द का यह शुभ सन्देश है कि, ''आज तुम्हारे लिए मुक्तिदाता का जन्म हुआ है।'' वह अदृश्य ईश्वर का प्रतिरूप है, उसको देखना पिता को देखने के समान है। उसके साथ सहभागी होना पिता के साथ सहभागी होने के समान है।

उसका नाम ईसा रखा गया, क्योंकि उसका जन्म

उसका जन्म हम सबके लिए बड़े आनन्द का समाचार है। उसका जन्म उसकी मृत्यु की प्रस्तावना था। चरनी में उसका जन्म, बेथलेहेम के नन्हें शिशुओं का जनसंहार- ये चिह्न थे, उस जीवन के जो उसकी प्रतीक्षा कर रहा था। वे क्रूस के चिह्न हैं। यह हमारे और ईश्वर के बीच टूटे हुए सम्बन्धों के भी चिह्न हैं, जिन्हें ईश्वर फिर से सुधारेगा। येसु हमें स्वतन्त्र कराने और हमारा उद्धार करने के लिए सब कुछ का परित्याग करते हैं। उसका जीवन और मृत्यु दोनों सिद्ध करते हैं कि वह वास्तव में जीवित ईश्वर का पुत्र है, लेकिन पुत्र को केवल विश्वास द्वारा ही जाना जा सकता है। मार्टिन लूथर कहते हैं, कि ''ईश्वर का वचन

लोगों को उनके पापों से छुड़ाने के लिए हुआ था।

और उसके कर्म में वास्तिवक विश्वास यह मांग करता है कि हम इसमें दृढ़ विश्वास करें कि ईसा का जन्म आप के लिए ही हुआ है और उसका जन्म आपका जन्म है। यही बात सुसमाचार भी हमें सिखाते हैं कि ख्रीस्त हमारे लिए ही जन्मे और हमारे लिए ही मरे और हमारे लिए ही सब कुछ सहा। स्वर्गदूत सिर्फ यह ही नहीं कहता है कि ख्रीस्त राजा का जन्म हुआ है। वह कहता है कि तुम्हारे लिए वो जन्मा है। वह नहीं कहता है कि मैं बड़े आनन्द का सन्देश लाया हूँ।'' वह कहता है, कि ''मैं तुम्हारे लिए बड़े आनन्द का संदेश लाया हूँ।''

जैसा कि संत योहन अपने पत्र में कहते हैं कि

हमें पवित्र आत्मा की सहायता चाहिए यह कहने के लिए कि येसु ख्रीस्त में ईश्वर मनुष्य बन गया (1 जॉन 4:2) अत: जब हम खीस्त जयन्ती का यह महापर्व मनाते हैं तो हमारा आचरण और व्यवहार ऐसा होना चाहिए कि हम विनम्रतापूर्वक अपनी असहायता स्वीकार करें कि हम ईश्वर की किसी भी बात या योजना को समझने में अपनी ओर से कोई भी या कैसी भी प्रगति नहीं कर सकते। यह एक ईश्वरीय वरदान है जिसके लिए हमें उत्सुकता और विमन्नतापूर्वक निरन्तर प्रार्थना करनी चाहिए, क्योंकि ईश्वर चतुर और धूर्त लोगों के समक्ष अपने को कभी भी प्रकट नहीं करता। स्वर्ग राज्य के भेद या रहस्य केवल छोटे बच्चों को ही दिये जाते हैं क्योंकि वे हृदय से कोमल और मन से विनीत होते हैं। बेथलेहेम के विनम्र चरवाहों को ही सबसे पहले येसु के जन्म का शुभ सन्देश मिला और उन्होंने ही देहधारी ईश्वर के दर्शन किये।

''ईश्वर न केवल विनम्र लोगों को अपने दर्शन देता है बल्कि उनके हृदयों में भी निवास करता है।" (ईसायह 57:15) संत मदर टेरेसा कहती हैं कि सज्जनता और शुद्धता के अभाव में हम येसु और उसकी माता की वास्तविकता की तुलना मृत वस्तुओं के साथ ही करेंगे। आपकी स्वयं परिपूर्णता, आपका स्वार्थ और आपका बौद्धिक अहम उसे आपके हृदय में आने से रोकेंगे, क्योंकि ईश्वर वह नहीं भर सकता जो पहले से ही भरा हुआ है। यदि हम यह विश्वास नहीं करते तो हम अंधकार में रहते हैं। यह अंधकार हमारे जीवन में भय और दुख लाता है। यदि हम विश्वास नहीं करते तो हम जीवन के वास्तविक अर्थ को नहीं समझ पाते और हमारे भविष्य के लिए कोई आशा नहीं है। इस सत्य में विश्वास करना कि ईश्वर मनुष्य बन गया है का मतलब है कि संदेह और अंधकार में नहीं भटकना, इसका अर्थ है कि ईश्वर की दुनिया में प्रवेश करना अर्थात वास्तविकता में विश्वास करना। देहधारण में विश्वास नहीं करने का अर्थ है कि भले लोगों के बीच में सच्ची शान्ति. सच्चा आनन्द और सच्ची आशा कभी नहीं हो सकती। देहधारण के विश्वास के अभाव में खीस्त जयंती मनाने से हमें कुछ लाभ नहीं होगा। रहस्यमय एन्जलूस सिलेसियुस कहते हैं कि ''यदि ख्रीस्त बेथलेहेम में हजारों बार जन्म ले लें किन्तु तुम में नहीं, तुम फिर

जन्म ले सके। आप सबको क्रिसमस एवं नववर्ष को हार्दिक शुभकामनाएं और आशीष! प्रभु में आपका,

भी अनन्त काल तक खोये रहोगे।'' आइए इस ख्रीस्त

Somebody asked Mercedes-Benz engineer Béla Barényi who invented this amazing technology, "Have you patented this technology?" He replied, "There are certain things in life that are so important and good that you MUST JUST SHARE!"

Friends, take a pause and just check - 'What's the best thing that has ever happened to you?' For some of you, it might be when you graduated or when you met your spouse or when you purchased your dream house etc. But, for how many of us, was it, 'when we met Jesus'? Now if it was when we met Jesus, then the best thing that we can do for others is obviously - 'TO SHARE JESUS'. St. Paul says, "I am under obligation, and for my part, I am eager to preach the Gospel." Will you be excited to talk about the cure and share it with others or not? What's the difference? PERSONAL EXPERIENCE! Until you and I have a personal experience with the Lord, we will not be excited. Is it possible... we have religion, but we never had a personal experience with the saving power of Jesus? When we encounter Jesus, we can't stop sharing about Him with others.

How do we share Christ? PRAY- CARE - SHARE. Colossians 4:3-4 says, "And pray for us, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should. "First of all, we need to pray that God may give us the opportunity and wisdom to share Him. Then, we engage in the lives of others by extending compassionate care.

Now is it enough to just pray and care? If you do good deeds for your neighbor, but if you don't share Christ with him, he will conclude that Christians are good people. They do good deeds... that's all! You and I got to share Christ... otherwise they will never know what motivated us to do good deeds.

It broadens the heart rebuilding the fabric of relationships for a more fraternal humanity. "Christmas is the season of goodwill, and can be a tough time for many people, including those who are homeless, recently bereaved, lonely or struggling to make ends meet. Research shows that acts of kindness can have a huge benefit to your own happiness, health and sense of wellbeing as well as those of the people you help.

Let us ask the Lord to grant us the grace of looking upon the crib this Christmas night with the simplicity of the shepherds, so as to receive the joy with which they returned home. Let us ask him to give us the humility and the faith with which Saint Joseph looked upon the child that Mary had conceived by the Holy Spirit. Let us ask the Lord to let us look upon Him with that same love with which Mary saw Him. And let us pray that in this way the light that the shepherds saw will shine upon us too, and that what the angels sang that night will be accomplished throughout the world: "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among people with whom he is pleased." Let us prepare ourselves to enjoy the blessings of Christmas in our individual and family life and ask the divine grace to be the heralds of joy, peace and hope everywhere and respond to that presence positively in all possible ways. The Holy Father's Prayer Intention DECEMBER - 2021

Intention for Evangelization - Catechists:

Let us pray for the catechists, summoned to announce the Word of God: may they be its witnesses, with courage and creativity and in the power of the Holy Spirit.

We Three Kings!

(A Study Based on Biblical, Historical and Geographical Approach)

Biblical & Historical Parenthesis - Three Kings



Let us clear our doubt about, who are exactly these three kings? The evidence from the gospel is found in Matthew's account (Mt 2: 1-12). All we can glean from that passage is that they are the three kings.

Classical figures in every Nativity set - one king on a camel, one kneeling at the manger and one standing ready to offer his gift. But who were Wise Men and what do we know about them? Who were the Magi?

Magi or 'magicians,' they came from the East to Jerusalem and they had seen a star announcing the birth of the King of the Jews. The gospel does not say there three Wise Men. That ideas comes from the three gifts they brought. To track down who the Wise Men were, we must first look East.

Geographical Parenthesis - East

The obvious choice is the Parthian Empire. During the time of Jesus, the Parthian Empire was the name of what was formerly the Persian Empire. It was centered on the present day Iran and Iraq. In the Parthian Empire there was a caste of astrologer priests based in the ancient religion of Zoroastrianism. Most scholars think the Magi were Zoroastrian priest-astrologers from Persia. However, none of this is recorded in Matthew's gospel. Neither is there a mention that the Wise Men were kings - nor are there camels in Matthew's account.

So, where did the idea come from that the Wise Men were camel-riding kings? The idea of three kings and the presence of camels is linked with two OT prophesies. Psalms 72:10-11 reads, "May the

kings of Tarshish and the islands bring tribute, the kings of Sheba and Seba offer gifts. May all kings bow before him, all nations serve him." Isaiah 60 which also read in the liturgy on the feast of the Epiphany and like Psalm 72, Isaiah highlights the dual meaning of the visit of the Wise Men: that the light of Christ has come into the world and is for all people - not only for the Jews.

The prophecy reads: "Arise! shine, for your light has come, the glory of the Lord has dawned upon you... Nations shall walk by your light, kings by the radiance of your dawning. Raise your eyes and look about; they all gather and come to you - Your sons from afar... Then you shall see and be radiant ... For the riches of the sea shall pour out before you, the wealth of nations shall come to you. Caravans of camels shall cover you, dromedaries of Midian and Ephah; All from Sheba shall come bearing gold and frankincense and heralding the praises of the Lord" (cf. Is 60:1-6).

Now we can see where the idea of kings and camels comes from. Matthew says the kings came from the East and Persia seems the obvious choice. but the passage from Isaiah predicts that the kings come from Ephah, Midian and Sheba. Where are Ephah, Midian and Sheba? Midian is the OT name for what was in Jesus' time, the kingdom of the Nabateans (cf Mk 3:7-8). It lies directly east and south of Jerusalem - in present day Jordan - and Ephah was a city of Midian further south in the Arabian Peninsula. The ancient Kingdom of Sheba was centered in what is present day Yemen, also to the east and south. If we are looking to the Scriptures for evidence, the prophecy from Isaiah suggests that the Wise Men came from what is now Jordan, Saudi Arabia and Yemen.

Midian especially was known for its abundance of camels. Can we use an OT prophecy to determine where the Wise Men came from? Those who believe in the accuracy of Biblical prophecy will not have a problem doing so. However, there are other indicators to suggest the Arabian Peninsula rather

If so, they probably did come on camels, since

Final Parenthesis - Three Gifts

than Persia.

The three gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh are overlooked as clues to solve the riddle. Where did the gold come from? As mentioned, Yemen is the present day location of the ancient civilization of Sheba. The kingdom's fabulous wealth was based on gold mines in Ethiopia. Archaeologists have recently discovered what they believe to be the mines of the queen of Sheba. The story of the queen

of Sheba (cf. 1 Kings 10), who came in procession

with great royal gifts of wealth establishes a

prophetic precedent. Just as the queen of Sheba

came to bear gifts to the Jewish king Solomon, so it

could be that the king of Sheba during Jesus' time

came, like his illustrious ancestors, to bear rich gifts to the king of the Jews. Furthermore, the kings of Yemen during the time of Jesus were Jewish. They would have had a keen

arrival of a new king of the Jews. Finally, Jesus himself mentions this link in Mt 12:42 when he refers to the gueen of Sheba's visit to Solomon and referring to himself says, "There is something greater than Solomon here." There are more intriguing clues based on three gifts.

The Arabian Peninsula, especially the area of Midian and Sheba - is the only place in the world where the specific plants grow from which are harvested the resin to make both incense and myrrh. These two rich gifts used for their aroma and for medicinal purposes - were the cash crops of this part of the world. The origin of the three gifts would indicate that the Wise men came from the Arabian Peninsula. And the gifts were not simply rich gifts offered to baby Jesus, but were symbolic gifts from the kingdoms of their origin.

The gifts had diplomatic significance and suggest

that the Magi were indeed either kings or ambassadors from the court of Nabatea and Sheba. Even more intriguing, there was constant traffic along the 'incense route' which came north from the southern tip of Arabia up to what is now Jordan and across Judea to Gaza. If magi were southern Arabia and the Kingdom of Nabatea (Present day Jordan), their trade route ran right past Jerusalem and Bethlehem. - Fr. Alok Toppo, Bengaluru

Unhappy Plight of the Poor



"The reality in the lives of the poor is only understood by the poor, who live in the world of the poor."

They live in huts, wretched homes, amidst unsanitary conditions, no

roof over their heads, pavement dwellers, living under bridges, platforms, roadsides, outside closed shops, rickshaws.



Daily life is a struggle, a real struggle for thousands for their basic necessities of life in which their life is sacrificed each day. Have we ever listened to their side of the story. They say we are treated like dogs, we have no life of our own, no time to think about our children, we just live only to serve, said a domestic worker. People affix terrible labels and condemn them with rude and nasty words, but to come closer to their lives, get under their skin and see their terrible plight is to discover for ourself the unhappy world they live in, exploited and oppressed.

Here are a few families undergoing difficulties; An old lady rejected by her own son, lives all alone, she is half blind, can't hear, she sells toys and feeds herself. The children playing on the street help her to put the bags of toys in the tempo and returning late evening, some other children, carry her bag and reach her home she struggles to walk in the dark for 15-20 minutes. Four times a week she goes to sell toys near a temple, the

people coming to pray, out of compassion buy her toys, She begs for food in the neighbouring houses. If she asks her son for food, he beats and sends her away. What a terrible plight to see this old mother being treated so cruelly with abusive words and beaten, by her son.



Mani Ram is on street for 5 long years, unwanted by his family and relatives, he is lame, he was given a wheel chair, as he went begging it overturned and he fell hurting himself very badly, now he is crippled on his second leg. Completely helpless. He is living at the mercy of the passers by even to get a bottle of drinking water, no baths for months together. I was ready to get him admitted in the ashram of Charity Sisters, but his wife, daughters and relatives didn't allow. Each time I visit him I see his terrible condition. I can only take food and hot tea for him and some fruits. I am really helpless to help him. It's terrible to see how he answers nature's call unexplainable. He feels so happy when I sit besides him and place my hand on his shoulder and talk to him and make him eat in my presence, people gather around him whenever I go. I tell some people there to bring him drinking water everyday. Some passersby give him some coins out of pity, some give him tea and food sometimes. He cries and tells please take me I am suffering here, with on one to help me.

Rajia 26 year old mother is sickly, swollen face and legs, when she feels better she goes to work, just 4 to 5 days, again on bed, no proper work for husband, so they find it difficult to get their daily bread. When she went for checkup before delivery, the nurse could not get any blood for testing. She was given half a litre of milk and some ration. After two weeks she went for delivery. Two hospitals rejected her saying she has no blood, we can't take the risk. The 3rd hospital by God's grace was ready provided they get 20 Thousand, only then she would be admitted. The husband went to his boss and asked him to lend the needed amount and deduct from his salary every month. The boss too didn't have, he borrowed from his friend and gave, she delivered a healthy baby girl it was a miracle both survived. Only prayers and the holy water in milk

and glucone D and praying fervently before the Blessed Sacrament and asking Jesus pour His blood into the mother and child, made this miracle possible for this poor family, by Jesus.

Machla and Bhoomi on the point of death having dengu. Their father said I have no money even to feed the family, so I can't take them to the doctor. He was so desperate, seeing his plight, I came to their rescue and did my level best, but most of all, prayers before the Blessed Sacrament, putting Holy water in the fruit juice and papaya leaves juice and pleading of the Lord, don't let them die, the five children will be orphans. It was God who did marvels for this family, who are rag-pickers. This Christmas let us seek Jesus in the poor and helpless and bring a ray of hope in their lives, remembering child Jesus laid in the cold manger and truly celebrate a joyous, blessed Christmas.

The Origin of the Christmas Crib

The origin of the Christmas Crib is often first ascribed to Saint Francis of Assisi, who in 1223 celebrated the Feast of the Nativity in a new way that led to a new devotional practice. Saint Francis sent for his friend, Giovanni Vellita, a

landowner in Greccio where Francis had a favourite hermitage. "If now it seems good to thee that we should celebrate this feast together, go

before me to Greccio and prepare everything as I tell thee. I desire to represent the birth of that Child in Bethlehem in such a way that with our bodily eyes we may see what He Suffered for lack of the necessities of a newborn babe and how He lay in a manger between the ox and ass."

Saint Bonaventure, Francis' biographer, said of the scene, "Many brothers and good people came at Francis' bidding, and during the night the weather also was beautiful. Many lights were kindled, songs and hymns were sung with great

solemnity so that the whole world echoed with the sound, and the men of God stood by the manger, filled with the utmost joy, and shedding tears of devotion and compassion. By his order the

manger had been so arranged that Mass was celebrated on it, and blessed Francis... sang the gospel and preached to the people on the Nativity of Christ our King, and whenever he pronounced His name with infinite tenderness he called Him the 'little Babe of Bethlehem.'"

(Recollection Talk Based on Gen. 9:18-27 given by Rev. Fr. Shajun on 24 Nov. 2021)



Let's begin with a prayer - the prayer of King David: Deal bountifully with your servant, that I may live and keep your word. Open my eyes that I may behold wondrous things out of your Law. And we pray Lord,

that on this blessed day you would open our eyes that we may see wondrous things in your word, and we pray that your word deal bountifully with us that we may live and keep your word. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen

Your Grace and Rev. Fathers for today's reflection I have taken a passage from the book of Genesis 9:18-27. In the book of Genesis there are four chapters devoted to Noah, his family and flood and so on. We read in the sixth chapter that when the wickedness of humankind was great in the earth, the Lord was sorry that He had made humankind on earth and it grieved Him to His heart. So the Lord said, I will blot out from the earth the human beings I have created together with animals and creeping things and birds of the air. But then only Noah found favour in the sight of God.

And we read in the Bible that Noah was a righteous man, obedient man, and how God saved him together with his family from the Great Flood. God makes a covenant of Grace with Noah. With Noah, God starts on the new world. God told Him to be fruitful and multiply just as He had said to Adam and Eve. God said to Noah to go out and settle the land, go out in the wilderness and make garden. And he obeys God and becomes the man of soil.

But then a significant event takes place in the

life of Noah. We are told that at the end of the chapter nine, Noah lived for another 350 years. And we don't hear anything about what happened at that time. There is only one event that took place in 350 years in Noah's life is highlighted. And this event is not pretty. Something does go wrong. And today I would like to invite you all to focus on this passage and be open to God's message for our life.

A Reading from the Book of Genesis 9:18-27 So here we have Noah, he was a master builder, he spent years constructing the Arc and now he became the man of soil. He became successful, made vineyard and produced wine from it. And God blessed him because of it. All went on well, so far so good. But then we read ahead-

He drank up the wine and became drunk and lay uncovered in his tent. Scripture generally refers wine as good thing a kind of blessing. However it is significant that the first mention of wine that we get in the Bible right here is associated with shame. Noah abuses the blessing of God and thus he passes out uncovered, he is naked. And it exposes him to shame. Noah the image of God with whom the Lord stared on the new earth is now lying naked, unconscious. The image of God is degraded and disgraced.

Now how did this happen? How did Noah all of a sudden given to this? He was a righteous man. In his generation he was blameless, continued in his obedience to God and enjoyed His blessings. He enjoyed the fruit of his labour. And he rightfully did, he had a glass of wine. But sadly this is when he led his guard down. When he was under the pressure of building that arc

standing strong. But now what he feels is that he is relaxed, the pressure is off and he let his guard down. The Lord had said to Cain, be vigilant and be filled with the spirit, for sin is crouching at the door. And at this time of relaxation Noah opened the door for Satan to enter in. Though he was a righteous man and faithful in his generation he was caught up in the sins of drunkenness.

with all the evil people around him, he stood

Dear brothers in Christ Jesus, the first lesson that we can learn from this state of Noah is -Even the most Godly are prone to sin. It could be a warning to us that after walking closely with God for years we could even fall at any moment of our life. We have many examples in our Bible like, Samson, King Saul. King Solomon, Judas. They had their moments of great glory and splendor. But when pride and self interest crept into their lives, they lost the touch of God's Hand. Our past Godliness doesn't guarantee future Godliness. Neither age nor maturity provides protection against temptation. We must walk in dependence upon the Lord daily. Noah's sin also teaches us that we are often the most vulnerable when the pressure is off. When Noah was surrounded by wickedness he lived righteously but when the storm was over he fell into sin. When the pressure is off, our self control comes down. Therefore we are reminded today to be vigilant and filled with the spirit, for sin is crouching at the door.

Now we read in the verse 22 that Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father and told his two brothers outside. This particular verse has been the subject of lots of debates and discussions among the scholars. The reason to talk about this is because some say that Ham's sin was graver than just seeing his father naked.

Some even associate Ham with sin of incest and homosexual. But anyway it is not helpful for our reflection. Let us focus on the main issue here. The face with which Ham saw his father's nakedness is not really the issue. The issue is he went out of the tent and told his brothers. That is the real sin of Ham. And the fact that he went out of the tent and told his brothers about his father reveals something about Ham's heart. Now let's consider this proverb for a moment. Proverbs 17:9 where we read, "whoever covers an offence seeks love but he who repeats a matter separates close friends". Whoever covers an offence seeks love. If Ham had loved his father he would have covered him up. But he didn't. He left him there naked and told his brothers. This reveals his heart that he hated his father, he had contempt for his father, and he publicly humiliated his father by reporting his nakedness to his brothers. This is the real sin that Ham committed. And this is the behavior we see in the devil. The devil is the accuser, the devil is the slanderer, and devil is the gossip. And this is what we see in Ham. He accuses his father, he slanders his father, and he is a gossip. The same thing happened with Adam and Eve. When they disobeyed God's word and listened to Satan's word they accused each other

saying; it's your fault, it's your fault.

Dear brothers in Christ Jesus, it is a warning for us. How do we respond to the other people's sin? How do we respond when other priests commit sin and offences? The way we respond to the sins of the others will reveal something about our heart. If we report the sin of the others and if we take delight and relish in gossip, and if we want let others to know about this person's weakness or this person's failure then that's not Godly to do, it is satanic. That's what the devil does.

The words of Noah here are not just words of curse or blessing but it is presented to us as an oracle, a prophecy. That the descendent of Canaan will be the cursed people, hate filled and rebellious people. And the Church history witnesses to this prophecy. The Israelites entered the Promised Land defeating the Canaanites, the descendent of Canaan. And the Blessing on Shem and Jephat also is fulfilled as we see the people of Israel, the so called the descendent of Shem and Jephat are now called as the covenant people, God's chosen people.

We are too indeed the descendents of Ham and Jephat through family line of Jesus.

Silence: Let's listen to the warnings that we

get from the life of Noah. There is a call for all of us- to be sober minded, to be self controlled. This is the fruit of the Spirit, that is self-control and sober minded. And it's a reminder to watch ourselves; sin is crouching at the door. We need to be vigilant; we need to keep our eyes open. And it is a reminder to us that how we respond to others when they fall and how do we respond to other's sin. Do we expose it as Ham did and brought curses to his descendents? Or do we cover it as Shem and Jephat did and bring blessings to all? Above all, love one another earnestly, since love covers the multitude of sins.



ST. PETER'S COLLEGE: A Saga of Selfless Service and Excellence



St. Peter's College has entered the dodransbicentennial (175 year) of its establishment. For the past 175 years the College has done yeoman's service in the field of education and has carved a niche for itself in the educational map of the country in particular and of the world in general. The journey of 175 years has been a long one, serving the nation with a stamp of distinction that has been the hallmark of the College.

The College has maintained a consistently high position for 175 years which has been by no means an easy task. It has required the toil and sweat, dedication and sacrifice, mission and planning of its administrators, teachers and other employees. It has also required the active cooperation of the parents and the well-wishers.

Danish philosopher Soren Keirkegarrd Said, "Life can only be understood backwards, but it must be lived forwards". The 175 years of existence of the College allows us to reflect on the achievements of the past but challenges us to look ahead. It reminds us that we must protect what is precious from the past, and look forward and continue to innovate and strive to excel.

Numerous and significant changes have occurred nationally and globally after the establishment of the College in 1846. But the College has stood the test of time, has thrived telling the story of courageous leadership, vision, mission and the zeal of the pioneers who explored the unchartered areas to disseminate light of knowledge. Along the way it has adapted to the shifting sands of changing education style. Thus the Anniversary is an occasion to look back in time, pause and reflect on our identity, who we are and where we are heading. Our long history provides us outposts to explore new areas, the vantage point from where new knowledge is to be sought. St. Peter's has lived up to its mission and belief that the young men that come out of the institution should be men of great calibre and charisma making a tangible difference in their world.

Though St. Peter's has seen impressive growth and expansion over 175 years, the mission remains the same - to prepare young boys for academic success in the College and to challenge and inspire them to be leaders for good in the world. In the book of Isaiah chapter 33 verse 6 we read "And wisdom and knowledge shall be thy stability of the times, and strength and salvation: the fear of the Lord is his treasure."

The Gospel power of witnessing vibrated

through the 175 years, guaranteeing the mission of the Church, has had its influence over the society and culture. Christ's vision of the human person, of life and of the world have been the well-knit fibre of the educational service rendered by the hard labour of all who headed the institution and the Archbishops who shepherded the diocese.

We gratefully remember all the Bishops and Archbishops, especially Archbishop Joseph Anthony Borghi, O.F.M. Cap., the founder of the College. His enterprise, labour and devotedness to the cause of education were well-known throughout India.

There have been many who have toiled and

laboured to make St. Peter's what it is today. The administrative arrangement of the College in the first 125 years of its existence was that, a Rector was the Chief Administrative head. A Headmaster was appointed to look after teaching, discipline and other extracurricular activities. We are beholden to all of them who served the College from 1841 to 1966. In 1966 this arrangement of Rector and Headmaster was replaced by a single functionary, the Principal, Rev. Fr. Columban Gomes being the first incumbent on that post. Many activities took place during his principalship which helped the institution to grow by leaps and bounds.

Fr. Alexander took over as Principal in 1976. He remained in office for less than two years.

In 1978 Fr. Jerome D' Souza became the Principal. His tenure witnessed overall development in academic and co-curricular fronts.

Fr. Sebastian Pantaladi who succeeded Fr. Jerome was the first diocesan priest to hold the post from 1983 to 1986. To cope with the increasing number of students new sections were

Fr. Jose Maliekal took over as Principal in 1986, who ensured that students have a productive ambience to study.

In 1987 Fr. George Paul assumed office as Principal. During his tenure stress was given to extracurricular activities like games, Sports, dramatics, debates etc. Academic excellence reached a new height during his principalship.

Fr. Dennis D' Souza took over in 1995. It was during his tenure that the College celebrated its 150 th Anniversary. His motto was "discipline with love" but never compromised with anyone who indulged in indiscipline.

Fr. Mathew Kumblumottil was appointed Principal in 2001. He got the Primary wing constructed in 2005. He maximised the learning potential of the students by developing a fear-free ambience which helped develop a strong bond between the students and teachers.

Fr. John Ferreira succeeded Fr. Mathew. His tenure witnessed the construction of the Main Gate, Yoga Gallery, and Yoga Hall. The statue of the Christ the Redeemer was also erected in the eastern side of the 'A' field. A yoga exponent, he proved that Yoga not only nourishes the body of the students but also brings discipline in their lives.

Fr. Dr. Paul Thannickal took over the reins of the College in 2013. His principalship was known for stress on discipline and academics. The renovated Senior Block, the Archbishop Albert D' Souza Silver Jubilee Memorial Hall, the very hall where you are seated are his

additions to the infrastructure of the College. And I have been doing my best to follow their footprints in my capacity as the Principal.

Saint of the Month St. Nicholas

Feast Day: 06 December



St. Nicholas, also called Nicholas of Bari or Nicholas of Myra, (flourished 4th century, Myra, Lycia, Asia Minor [near modern Demre, Turkey]; Western feast day December 6; Eastern feast day December 19), one of the most popular minor saints commemorated in the Eastern and Western churches and now traditionally associated with the festival of Christmas. In many countries children receive gifts on December 6, St. Nicholas Day. He is one of the patron saints of children and of sailors.

Nicholas's existence is not attested by any historical document, so nothing certain is known of his life except that he was probably bishop of Myra in the 4th century. According to tradition, he was born in the ancient Lycian seaport city of Patara, and, when young, traveled to Palestine and Egypt. He became bishop of Myra soon after returning to Lycia. He was imprisoned and likely tortured during the persecution of Christians by the Roman emperor Diocletian but was released under the rule of Constantine the Great. He may have attended the first Council of Nicaea (325), where he allegedly struck the heretic Arius in the face. He was buried in his church at Myra, and by the 6th century his shrine there had become well known. In 1087 Italian sailors or merchants stole his alleged remains from Myra and took them to Bari, Italy; this removal greatly increased the saint's popularity in Europe, and Bari became one of the most crowded of all pilgrimage centres.

Nicholas's reputation for generosity and kindness gave rise to legends of miracles he performed for the poor and unhappy. He was reputed to have given marriage dowries of gold to three girls whom poverty would otherwise have forced into lives of prostitution and to have restored to life three children who had been chopped up by a butcher and put in a tub of brine. In the Middle Ages, devotion to Nicholas extended to all parts of Europe. He became the patron saint of Russia and Greece; of charitable fraternities and guilds; of children, sailors, unmarried girls, merchants, and pawnbrokers; and of such cities as Fribourg, in Switzerland, and Moscow. Thousands of European churches were dedicated to him—one, built by the Roman emperor Justinian I at Constantinople (now Istanbul), as early as the 6th century. Nicholas's miracles were a favourite subject for medieval artists and liturgical plays, and his traditional feast day was the occasion for the ceremonies of the Boy Bishop, a widespread European custom in which a boy was elected bishop and reigned until Holy Innocents' Day (December 28).

After the Reformation, devotion to Nicholas disappeared in all the Protestant countries of Europe except Holland, where his legend persisted as Sinterklaas (a Dutch variant of the name St. Nicholas). Dutch colonists took this tradition with them to New Amsterdam (now New York City) in the American colonies in the 17th century. Sinterklaas was adopted by the country's English-speaking majority under the name Santa Claus, and his legend of a kindly old man was united with old Nordic folktales of a magician who punished naughty children and rewarded good children with presents. The resulting image of Santa Claus in the United States crystallized in the 19th century, and he has ever since remained the patron of the gift-giving festival of Christmas.

Indian Catholic Press Association Annual Meet in Mumbai



Mumbai, Dec 1, 2021: Nearly 45 catholic journalists from across India attended the National Convention of Indian Catholic Press Association (ICPA) on Dec. 1, 2021 in Mumbai. The theme for the convention was: "Hit the Streets: Listen, Encounter, Engage" based on Pope Francis's message this year for the World Communications Day that focuses on "Come and See (Jn 1:46): Communicating by Encountering People Where and as They Are."

Speaking at the inaugural function, Justice Aloysius Aguiar, a former Judge of Bombay High Court, said, "A good journalist is one who hits the street in pursuit of truth despite all the hardships and threats to life. But unfortunately, the fourth pillar of democracy in the country has failed in its sacred duty of scrutinizing the government's policies and programs. Instead, it has turned out to be a pliable institution trying to live out of the 'favors' dished out by the government."

In a panel discussion on the theme, speakers expressed concern over how media has failed to be a watchdog and instead it has become a tool to peddle fake news and spread misinformation and a means to malign individuals and denigrate communities. The panellists were Mohan Sivanand, former editor-in-chief of Reader's Digest, Jesuit activist Father Cedric Prakash and ShaisonOuseph, head of Department for Film and Television, St. Xavier Institute of Communications in Mumbai.

Sister Sujata Jena, a nun-political-activist belonging to the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary, Odisha, Father Cedric Prakash, a well-known Jesuit activist Priest based in Gujarat and Ranchi based Hindi magazine Nishkalanka, were awarded during the convention for their courageous contribution to the people through media activism.

The final statement urged journalists to have the courage to heal the illness plaguing society. "Today we pledge to listen to the people, encounter and engage with them to make our communication more effective and responsive until that time truth, justice, reconciliation and peace prevail," the statement added.

Social Justice Crusader, Father Cedric Prakash, SJ appealed to all journalists to stick out their necks and fight for a just, free and equitable world. Accepting the Indian Catholic Press Association (ICPA) award, Father Prakash said "We need to wake up now, to be visible and vocal, to use our God-given talents for a more harmonious and peaceful world."He called upon the media to fight a relentless war on behalf of the poor and the marginalized. He asked media persons not to get carried away by electronic gadgets and to concentrate on their core concerns of fighting for human rights.

Sr. Sujata Jena who writes for various national and international online portals to highlight the

plight of the marginalized and bonded labourers, made a passionate plea to continue the fight against discrimination for the weaker sections of the society. The SC/BC Special Award was instituted by the ICPA and sponsored by the CBCI office for Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes to promote the welfare of the marginalized peoples.

In his video message, His Eminence, Cardinal Oswald Gracias, Archbishop of Mumbai and President of the Catholic Bishops Conference of India congratulated the ICPA members. He stressed the importance of the word of the Gospel on issues of social justice and human rights.
